

How to pair PS4 controller with your iPhone or iPad

- 1. Open the Settings app.
- 2. Press Bluetooth. Bluetooth is probably already on, but if it isn't, flip the Bluetooth toggle at the top of the next page to green.
- 3. While the Bluetooth menu is still open, grab your DualShock 4 controller and make sure it's charged.
- 4. Press the **PlayStation** button and the Share button at the same time and hold them down for a few seconds. The light on the back of your DualShock 4 should start flashing intermittently.
- 5. On your iPhone or iPad, you should see "DUALSHOCK 4 Wireless Controller" pop up under Other Devices in the Bluetooth menu. Press it.
- **6.** The light on the back of your DualShock should stop blinking and should switch to a reddish colour once the controller is paired

How to pair PS4 controller with your Mac

- 1. Press and hold the **PlayStation** button and **Share** button to put the controller into pairing mode.
- 2. On your Mac, go to Bluetooth settings either from the Bluetooth drop-down in the Menu Bar or from System Preferences.
- 3. In the device list for Bluetooth settings, look for "Wireless Controller" to pop up.
- 4. Click the Connect button.

How to pair PS4 controller with your PC

Due to lack of official support from Sony for its PS4 controller on Windows, you'll need to install third party software to get the controller working properly in-game such as DS4 Windows.

This applies also to connect a PS4 controller through USB.

- 1. With the DualShock 4 turned off (You'll know by the deactivated light bar), press and hold the PlayStation and Share buttons for three seconds until the light bar starts double flashing.
- 2. Access the Bluetooth menu on your PC via the system tray or the Windows Parameters.
- 3. Make sure to turn on "Bluetooth".
- 4. Click "Add Bluetooth or other device".
- 5. Select the "Wireless Controller" or "DualShock 4 Wireless" from the list that pops up.
- **6.** Launch DS4 Software and check that your PS4 controller is detected.

How to pair PS4 controller with your Android device

- 1. On the PS4 controller, press and hold the PS button and the Share button at the same time. When the light bar starts flashing, you can release the buttons.
- 2. On your Android device, swipe down from the top edge of the screen to view the Quick Settings. Press and hold your finger on the Bluetooth symbol to quickly see your Bluetooth settings.
- 3. If you can't see a Bluetooth symbol, open your Apps list and tap on the Settings icon. You can usually find Bluetooth under Device connection or Wireless & Networks, depending on your device.
- 4. Make sure Bluetooth is turned on by tapping the switch at the top of the screen.
- 5. You will see a list of nearby Bluetooth devices. Tap on Wireless Controller to start pairing your PS4 controller.
- **6.** Confirm you want to pair with the controller by tapping Pair. After a few seconds, the pad will appear under Paired devices.
